1. Visit "https://check.spamhaus.org/ "and input the listed Public IP Address for checking.



2. After checking your **Public IP address** for listing click the drop down "**Show Details**" then Click "**I am running my own mail server**" and proceed to next step.

• Note that not all listed IP address are available for removal request some of it needs a settings reconfiguration to be delisted.

4. After submitting the information needed you will be redirected to **confirmation page** and will guide you to check the email verification just to confirm that the request is legit and not a bot automated request.



- 5. Check your email for verification and visit the link provided by Spamhaus.
 - Make sure to check your email Spam Folder due to sometimes email filters/email securities marked it as **SPAM** EMAIL
 - Sometimes it takes minutes for the email to arrive so kindly wait for the verification email instead of requesting another delisting request.



- 6. You will be redirected to a confirmation page and will show that the delisting was successful.
 - Note that It takes 1 hour for the propagation of delisting.
